

Federico Revelli holds a PhD in Economics from University College London (1998) and is Full Professor of Public Economics at the Department of Economics and Statistics « S. Cagnetti de Martiis » of the University of Torino. Since 2015 he has been the Head of the Department. He serves as Associate Editor of *International Tax and Public Finance* and of *Economia Politica: Journal of Analytical and Institutional Economics*. He is member of the International Institute of Public Finance and fellow of the CESifo (Munich) Research Network. He has acted as referee for over 40 international journals including top general interest and top field journals, and has given invited talks at over 30 Universities. His research deals with decentralized fiscal decision-making, intergovernmental fiscal relations, local elections, budget cycles, cultural heritage, environmental issues, and internal migration, and has been published in several journals, including the *Journal of Applied Econometrics*, *Journal of Economic Behavior & Organization*, *Journal of Law & Economics*, *Journal of Public Economics*, *Journal of Urban Economics*, *Public Choice*, and the *Oxford Economic Papers*.
